

## What to expect in 2022

We're making some changes to our plans to offer more coverage for our members. Specific copays, cost shares, and coverage will vary, especially between our San Antonio and Houston service areas. We're also updating which services require prior authorization. Learn more at [devoted.com/providers-tx](https://devoted.com/providers-tx).

### Important updates for our plans

- 1 We're improving dental coverage and increasing comprehensive allowance amounts.
- 2 We're introducing BeWell (C-SNP HMO), a chronic special needs plan for members in San Antonio living with diabetes. It requires no referrals for endocrinologist and nephrologist visits.

### Our 2022 benefit changes



#### Monthly premiums

- Changing to \$25.10 for Prime (HMO) plan
- Members with LIS ("Extra Help") will have premiums reduced to as low as \$0
- Continuing to offer \$0 monthly premium for Core (HMO) plan



#### Dental

- Enhancing to include coverage for bridges
- Removing 50% coinsurance from crowns and root canals
- Increasing comprehensive dental allowance to \$3,000 for Core (HMO) plan and \$3,500 for Prime (HMO) plan in San Antonio, and \$3,000 for Core (HMO) plan and \$5,000 for Prime (HMO) plan in Houston

## Our 2022 benefit changes (continued)



### Medical

- Cost shares are changing



### Part D

- Increasing Prime (HMO) plan Part D deductible for San Antonio to \$480 and cost share to 25% for Tiers 3 through 5
- Members with LIS (“Extra Help”) will pay LIS cost share amounts
- Reducing Core (HMO) plan Part D deductible for San Antonio to \$0
- Introducing low-cost insulin with coverage through the gap for BeWell (C-SNP HMO) plan, and removing low-cost insulin for (HMO) plans in San Antonio
- Select insulin will be covered on the Houston plans with some copay changes
- Continuing low-cost insulin with coverage through the gap for Houston
- Continuing full Tier gap coverage for Tiers 1 and 2 for Houston and partial Tier gap coverage for Core (HMO) and Prime (HMO) plans in San Antonio
- Increasing Prime (HMO) plan Tier 3 copay for Houston to \$40 for a 30-day retail supply



### Over-the-counter allowance

- Increasing to \$65 each month for Prime (HMO) plan in Houston



### Healthy Foods card

- Benefit for Prime (HMO) and BeWell (C-SNP HMO) members with a qualifying condition in San Antonio
- Up to \$50 each month to help with the cost of healthy foods



### Eyewear

- Increasing eyewear allowance to \$325 each year for Prime (HMO) plan in San Antonio



### Acupuncture

- Removing coverage for 12 supplemental acupuncture visits
- No change to Medicare-covered acupuncture for chronic lower back pain
